## About the Legal Aid Society and the Volunteer Lawyers Project

The Legal Aid Society of Greater Cincinnati has been providing legal services in our community for over one hundred years through legal representation, information, advice and referral for people in need of legal help.

The Legal Aid Society of Greater Cincinnati coordinates its work with the Volunteer Lawyers Project (VLP). VLP pro bono lawyers provide high-quality legal services to low-income citizens in seven southwest Ohio counties: Brown, Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton, Highland, and Warren. The VLP recruits private attorneys to handle at least two pro bono cases each year. Cases handled by Volunteer Lawyers are common to a general civil practice and may require anything from one hour of work to full-scale representation.
